

# Library Scavenger Hunt

Your Task:

- Your scavenger hunt will include four possible pieces of information about each book, with various portions missing. It is your job to use the computer catalog to fill in the missing information.
- You and your partner will work cooperatively to locate books on the computer catalog and will then locate that book in the LMC. Each team will be seated at a computer with a different scavenger hunt sheet. Here are your jobs.
- Reader and Recorder: This student reads the information from book search sheet, assists the searcher in entering the information into the computer and records the missing information on the search sheet when the two members have agreed.
- Searcher: This student fills in the information on the computer that is known about the book, as well as the status of the book, and then proceeds to find the call number of the missing book.
- You will then switch roles for the next question. This procedure continues for each question.
- Once you have filled in the information on your scavenger sheets, you are to find the six books listed on your scavenger sheet and take them to Mrs. Dobrodt, Mrs. Kimball, Mrs. Sexton or your teacher to be checked.
- You will be assessed using the following rubric.
