

TASK #6 – Colony Map Identification

Standard: C.U.1.4 (SWBAT Analyze the political, social, and economic development of colonial America)

Description: For this activity you will be labeling the 13 original colonies on a color coded map and identifying which colonial section each colony belonged to. Afterwards, you will create a chart that identifies each colony and its various features.

Map Labeling:

- New England Colonies
 - Massachusetts Bay, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New Hampshire
- Middle Colonies
 - New Jersey, Pennsylvania, New York, Delaware
- Southern Colonies
 - Chesapeake Colonies
 - Virginia, Maryland
 - North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia

Chart:

- 13 Colonies
- Date Founded
- Founder(s)
- Motivation for settling
- Significance of settlement/colony

Criteria:

- Accurate identification of colonies
- Color coded & labeled
- Accurate information (chart)
