Create a scale drawing of the quilt that you designed. Give the scale that you used to create your drawing. List the size, shape, color, and number of each different piece. Write a paragraph explaining what technique you used and why you used it. Use geometric language where appropriate.

Ask a classmate to review your project with you. Together, check that your quilt design is complete, your diagrams are clear, and your explanations and information are accurate. Is the display attractive, organized, and comprehensive?
